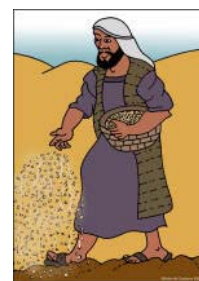

Catholic Charities of the Diocese of Youngstown recently completed the **2010 Catholic Charities USA Annual Survey**, which collects information on services, collaborative efforts, social action initiatives, parish relationships, personnel, volunteers and finances from Catholic Charities organizations across the United States. **Catholic Charities’** housing services experienced a 77% increase from 2009 to 2010. This significant increase is due in large part to the federal Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-housing Program offered at Catholic Charities Regional Agency and Catholic Charities of Ashtabula County. Emergency shelter assistance rose by 40%, which includes the number of people receiving rental assistance to avoid eviction and potential homelessness. Catholic Charities Housing Opportunities provided down payment assistance to 16 qualifying households last year.
