For nearly three years, Mary's Kitchen has served the community by providing food as well as fellowship to anyone who comes through the doors. This year alone, more than 385 people have been served at a cost of approximately \$1,200 through funding by the St. Vincent de Paul Society. On average there are nine volunteers each month (ranging in age from 8 to 92) serving, washing dishes, greeting guests, etc.

Now, due to the high costs of insurance, St. Vincent de Paul will no longer be providing funds for Mary’s Kitchen. It will be funded completely by St. Mary/St. Frances Cabrini Parish.

Beginning the weekend of October 22/23, a collection will be taken following the Masses to support this ministry. Future collections will be taken the third Sunday of the month, as needed. This parish outreach depends on monetary contributions as well as the many volunteers who donate soup, make desserts and give of their time to serve this monthly meal.

Please consider spending time with us on the last Saturday of each month to have the opportunity to truly give of yourself to others. With the generous support of our parish, may we continue to serve God's people for many years to come.
