Dear Members of St. Mary/St. Frances Cabrini,

I want to tell you about trees coming down at St. Mary Church and the “handicap accessible restroom” in the vestibule of St. Frances Cabrini Church.

There are three large maple trees that have been growing along the west side of the bus garage pushing against the wall of the garage. Due to the damage that they can do to the foundation these trees are being taken down on November 12. Also the large evergreen along State Street will also be taken down due to its size and potential to cause damage to the rectory and sidewalk if it were to be blown down. This has been reviewed and recommended by the Buildings and Grounds Committee.

The “handicap accessible restroom” in the vestibule of St. Frances Cabrini Church has been out of order due to an inoperable or broken sewage line. Preliminary digging on Thursday seems to indicate that the sewage line to which the toilet was connected may have been inoperable or has recently cracked. Without having any drawings of the sewage and water lines around the church, there was no information about the existing line that was initially installed when the church was built but never connected for one reason or another. Work on this will be done this coming week with the hope of having the restroom back in use by the end of the week. Thank you for your patience with this.
