

**Financial Report from the  
Society of St. Vincent de Paul  
St. Mary/St. Frances Cabrini Parish  
January 1 – December 31, 2009**

*With your generous donations to the St. Vincent de Paul Society, our parish lived the gospel message by providing assistance to more than 700 people in the Conneaut area . . .*

**“I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink” . . .**

St. Vincent de Paul provided \$2,711.76 in food vouchers to families requesting food assistance and sponsored the St. Joseph’s Day Altar to collect food for the Food Pantry. The Society provided \$934.70 in funding to Mary’s Kitchen. The last Saturday of each month, Mary’s Kitchen provides a homemade luncheon meal to the community at no cost.

**“I was naked and you gave me clothing” . . .** St. Vincent de Paul provided \$1,281.76 through the “Small Soles” program to provide school shoes to area children.

**“I was a stranger and you gave me help” . . .** St. Vincent de Paul provided \$9,901.34 to help families and individuals to pay utility and rent expenses. St. Vincent de Paul provided \$579.92 to purchase school supplies for children distributed by the Human Resource Center.

**“I was sick and you took care of me” . . .** St. Vincent de Paul provided \$622.84 for prescription costs, doctor and dental expenses.

**“I was in prison and you visited me” . . .** St. Vincent de Paul provided \$447.62 in assistance for gasoline cards to provide transportation to doctor’s appointments and job interviews and a walker for an invalid. The Society sent Christmas cards and holy cards to all of the homebound in the parish.
