Stewardship Good stewards are like the industrious and reliable servants in today's Gospel, prudently using and multiplying the gifts entrusted to them by God.

Catholic Charities thanks the parishioners of St. Mary/St. Frances Cabrini for collecting \$689.25 in this year's First Step for Change campaign! With your assistance, we are able to provide food, formula, diapers and other forms of material assistance to pregnant women and families with children ages 0-3. Last year, Catholic Charities served 2,169 people in First Step programs across the diocese. A total of 1,722 adults and children received material assistance; 306 of them also received supportive case management services. We provided information and referral services to 920 people seeking specific community resources related to women's and children's services.

The Conneaut Salvation Army 'Red Kettle Drive'

Last year with the help of 'bell ringers' and business leaders, \$6,412.45 was raised to help those in need in the Monroe, Kingsville, North Kingsville, Pierpont and Conneaut area. Once again the parishioners of St. Mary/St. Frances Cabrini are being asked to be bell ringers each Friday (1pm-7pm) and Saturday (10am-7pm) from Nov 19-Dec. 24 (with the exception of Thanksgiving weekend, the collection will be taken Wednesday, Nov. 23, 9am-3pm) at the back door of Orlando Brothers Golden Dawn.
